General Information

This scholarship is provided through funds from the Estate of Dr. George T. Hoylman, who for many years was a Scout Leader in Braxton County and a great example of what Scouting represents. This is a one time cash scholarship of \$300, to be used by the recipient toward any part of their college/post high school educational expenses.

Requirements

1. Must be currently registered through an organization of the Boy Scouts of America.
2. Must be graduating from Braxton County High School.
3. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
4. Application deadline is March 15 of the year of application.
5. All sections of the application must be completed for the application to be considered.
6. The successful applicant must provide documentation of enrollment in a college/post high school institution by September 1 of the year of application..
