John was a heavy equipment mechanic, having worked on highway projects such as I-79, and then later on in the mining industry. He also enjoyed farming, having raised beef cattle most of his life. It is his families' and friends wish that this scholarship will assist a deserving student to further their education either in the mechanic field, or in the agriculture industry.

Complete this application in its entirety and submit it to the Braxton County High School Guidance Office no later than March 15. A copy of your high school transcript and your acceptance to a school beyond High School will be helpful in processing your application.

The amount of this scholarship will be a minimum of \$500, and will be awarded at the annual Senior Awards Assembly in the spring, and recognized at the Braxton County High School Commencement Ceremonies.

Applicants must:

- . Be a citizen of Braxton County
- . Be a senior at Braxton County High School
- . Plan on attending full time a 2 or 4 year college, or a technical or vocational school  
Majoring in mechanics or agriculture studies
- . Submit a completed application to the Braxton County High School Guidance Office no later than April 15
